- Ensure that your cell phone, if you have one, is turned off at all times in the theater

- Interest in providing students with an opportunity for community involvement and family activity
- A driver's license, adequate automobile insurance (see insurance requirements in handbook) and a vehicle
- An appreciation for theater is desired, although not required
