CHILDCARE WORKER (CONTRACT)

Essential Functions

- Supervise and ensure the safety of 1- 4 children at a time, ages 1-10 years
- Interact professionally with parents and communicate about their child's activities, behaviors, and related issues encountered in childcare
- Engage with children in recreational activities such as playing games, coloring, and reading books
- Support children's social development, encourage understanding of others, and provide redirection when needed
