

PS NATURE BINGO – A Photo Challenge!

INSTRUCTIONS

GUIDELINES FOR SAFETY

PS NATURE BINGO is one way to get outside, enjoy nature and take in a little vitamin D while we are all doing our part to help stop the spread of Covid-19. Please follow these guidelines so that we all stay safe and honor the request of our local officials and health care professionals.

- **Use this activity as a time to get outside with your family!**
 - This can be a fun activity to share with family members **from your household**. Please do not group up with friends or neighbors, as we all still need to follow social distancing guidelines.
- If a sibling or parent/guardian is not able to join you, make sure to let your parent/guardian know where you will be going and what time you plan to be back. Then, stick to the time you tell them. Show them the pictures you have taken and which bingo squares you have completed!
- You most likely will come across other people out on the trails or around your neighborhood. Remember to practice social distancing by staying 6 feet away at all times.
- You don't need to touch anything to participate in PS NATURE BINGO except for your phone/camera, but it's a good idea to bring a small bottle of hand sanitizer with you, just in case.
- Be aware of what you touch outside, and if you do have to touch anything (i.e. trash bin, picnic table, etc.), make sure to use hand sanitizer immediately after. Resist the urge to touch your eyes, nose or mouth.

RULES OF THE GAME

1. The **OBJECT** of PS NATURE BINGO is to take as many pictures with your phone/camera of the subjects on the BINGO card and enjoy being in nature while you do it!
2. In order to get credit for your nature finds, upload and title your photos in the Project Success PS NATURE BINGO group on the **Cluster** App. This app will allow you to share photos with Project Success and other participating PS students as a part of a private group. Photos can be uploaded directly from your phone OR your computer. If you have trouble joining the group, contact Outdoor Adventures Program Manager, Jenny, at JennyB@projectsuccess.org.

3. Gathering Photos: Take a walk in your backyard or neighborhood or drive to a park, lake or river with your family. Try to find the items in each of the BINGO squares. Take a photo of as many as you can! If you don't know what one of them is (i.e. mallard), ask a family member or look it up! But then, you must find it out in nature and take your own photo.
4. **NO CHEATING:** Photos must be yours and taken starting Monday, April 6. No sending photos from the web or pulling up old photos! 😊
5. Once you have completed 3 lines in the BINGO card (5 squares across, down or diagonal = 1 complete line), upload your photos to the Cluster App for a NATURE BINGO.
6. **The first 20 students to submit 3 lines in the BINGO card will be entered in a raffle for a chance to win a prize!**
7. **The first student to find all 25 squares, or blackout their board, will win a prize!**
8. Please note that many of these items will require you to go out on multiple days and/or visit various locations to find. Be patient, have fun, and most importantly, stay safe!
