ACTIVITIES

During the 2018-19 school year, Project Success served nearly 14,000 Minneapolis Public Schools students in 19 schools. Gifts to our Annual Fund helped to sustain our current programs, and commitments over and above annual support to the Dreams to Futures Program Expansion Campaign* made it possible to deepen and expand our program for more students. Activities included:

CURRICULUM

Our professional facilitators incorporate our curriculum objectives into each PS experience in and outside the classroom.

- + 4,200 monthly in-class goal-setting workshops connecting 13,209 students to their purpose.

ARTS

Experiencing theater and the arts are powerful ways to inspire self-expression, confidence, connection and discussion.

- + 97 different evening and weekend professional theater performances for 10,000 unique students and family members, thanks to generous ticket donations by our 40+ theater partners.
- + Three middle school student musicals by 220 students at 3 schools.

EXPEDITIONS


Project Success expeditions inspire growth and discovery, expand worldviews and open doors to possibility.

COLLEGE AND CAREER TOURS

- + 522 students explored future possibilities on 47 regional college tours.
- + 80 students learned about pathways to careers such as healthcare, technology, and the arts on 6 different college and career tours.*

GLOBAL EXPERIENCES

- + 38 English Learner high school students explored future possibilities and global leadership at Boston University and Harvard.*
- + 90 African American high school students explored identity and education at Howard University (an HBCU) and the National Museum of African American History and Culture in Washington DC.*
- + 8 middle school students explored themes of strength, identity and independence in Mexico.

Bringing students to professional theater performances and producing middle school musicals have been a part of the Project Success legacy for decades. In a ‘dream come true’ for our organization, gifts to the Dreams to Futures Campaign* allowed 5,000 students to experience Broadway’s *Hamilton* in September 2018 with Project Success.

PROGRAM COMPONENTS

OUTDOOR ADVENTURES

- + 136 middle school students learned grit, perseverance and survival skills on a 7-day Boundary Waters Canoe Area experience.
- + 520 students and family members experienced the outdoors in their own “backyards” on 3 adventure days focused on winter activities, sciences, and river ecosystems.*

CERTIFICATES

The Project Success Institute fully launched in September 2018, providing students with a deeper dive into skills that will take them through the rest of their lives. Our first full year of programming saw certificates offered in:


